Our priority is to ensure all our visitors have an enjoyable and safe visit. Please abide by our guidelines and the instructions of the staff at Dorset Museum & Art Gallery.

- Please be respectful of all other visitors to Dorset Museum & Art Gallery.
- Please do not leave any children in your care unattended or allow them to behave antisocially.
- Please avoid making so much noise or running about in such a way that you might stop someone else enjoying their visit.
- Children under 16 may not be admitted unaccompanied
- Children 16 or over are allowed to visit the Museum unaccompanied provided that they have parental permission and that they observe this code of behaviour.
- Please observe all normal health & safety signage around the Museum such as keeping emergency exits clear.
- In the event of an emergency and we need to evacuate the building, please follow instructions from Dorset Museum & Art Gallery staff and volunteers.
- Please look after your own personal property at all times.
- Please do not eat or drink in the Museum except in the Café or the Sculpture Courtyard
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere within the Dorset Museum & Art Gallery
- Photography and recording for private non-commercial purposes are permitted without the use of flash however please ensure that you do not inadvertently include others in your pictures or films without their permission. If a visitor complains that your photography, filming, or recording is intrusive you may be asked to stop and/or delete any imagery and/or leave the museum.

If you do not comply with any part of these regulations, you may be asked to leave the Museum.
